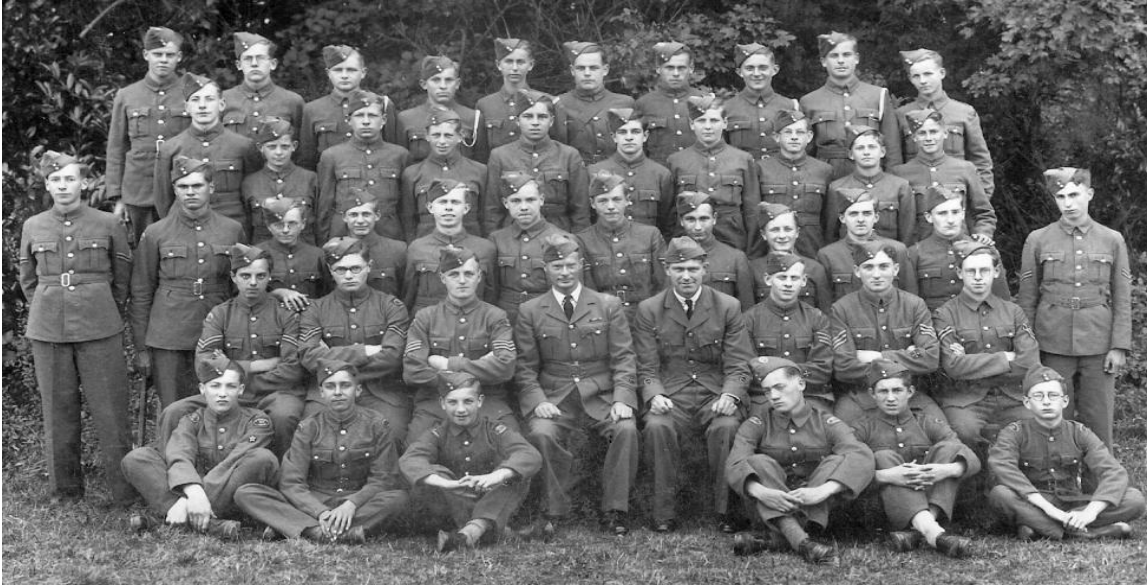

INSTRUCTIONS

I. TO THE CONTINGENT OFFICERS

This book is designed to contain a record of a cadet's career in the C.C.F. which will be of value to him in the Service which he eventually joins.

All entries are to be made by Contingent Officers except where otherwise specified. Remaining blank spaces will be plainly cancelled.

After completion the record will be certified by the Contingent Commander (on Page 3) and the book handed to the Cadet.
