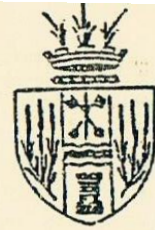

Despite many increasing costs the price has been fixed at a sum of £5-50p per head. With comparable numbers to last year this will cover the cost of the hall, buffet and other expenses.

Already several former staff from both schools have promised to attend these together with some of our overseas O.M's and quite a few new faces should help to make the evening very successful.

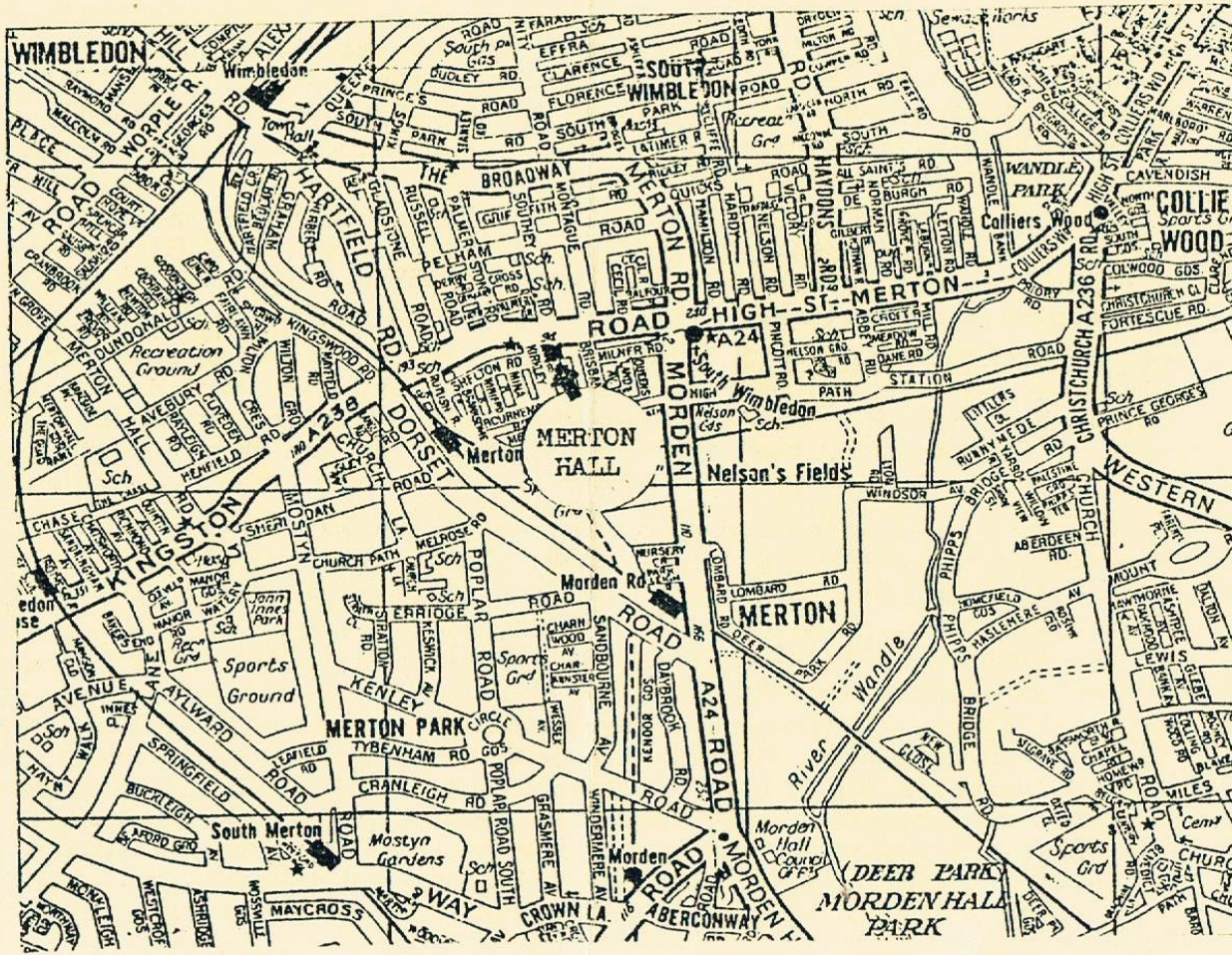

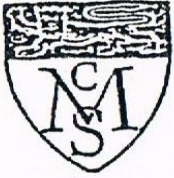

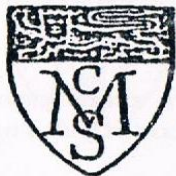
